Report to:	The Course Area Manager will travel along the course prior to the events starting and will make themselves known to you.

Sign In:	Report direct to your location
Role:	<p>To man and monitor an assigned road block location along the course.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please be in your specific location no later than your allocated start time. • Ensure <u>NO vehicles</u> enter the course. • Provide information to motorists as required e.g. Opening times and detour routes as advised by your Area Manager • Provide information to the public when approached • The event <u>cannot</u> begin until all road blocks are manned and controlled. • You will be advised by the traffic management team of when you can re-open your road block. Do not open your road block until you have had confirmation from Traffic Management or your Area Manager. • If in doubt contact Race Information. Please see the Communication information at the end of this document & take note of the contact numbers, or refer to your Volunteer Information Card. • You will receive a high visibility vest at the Volunteer Briefing. Please ensure you wear the vest while manning your allocated road block. Please return your vest to your Area Manager or Team Leader once your position has finished for the day. • Once you have received your position please review the specific details for this area so you are familiar with the requirements. All road closure details can be found here on the event website. • Please ensure you carry your fully charged mobile phone on you at all times as well as the Volunteer Information Card with the relevant Event phone numbers listed.
